George Kolba called the meeting to order at 4:02 PM. All six Board Members were present. Attendance sheet was passed for signatures. Fire exits were identified.

Edward Crumb made a motion for the Board to approve payment of a claim in the amount of \$350,853.00 from the State Retirement budget line (J9010.58000A) in the 2017 budget to reimburse the City of Binghamton for the December 2017 payment of the discounted FY2018 contribution due in February 2018; saving approximately \$3,000.00 by paying the claim now. Steve Andrew seconded the motion Motion carried 6/0

Edward Crumb made a motion for the Board to accept an installment payment in the amount of \$314,528.79 for PW-02504 (Flood Wall) to be credited to the Revenue line for Federal Aid – Emergency Disaster Assistance (J.44960) and to approve submission of a budget modification Request for Legislation to the Owners' Legislative Bodies to modify the Board's 2017 Budget in order to reimburse the entire amount of the check in their respective shares (54.8% to the City [\$172,361.78]; 45.2% to Village [\$142,167.01]) to be paid as soon as possible. Steve Andrew seconded the motion
