Project Description:

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) has prepared a draft permit and made a tentative determination, subject to public comment or other information, to approve a permit modification and renewal of the State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) Permit for the Binghamton Johnson City Sewage Treatment Plant (BJCSTP) facility, pursuant to 6 NYCRR Part 750. The facility currently discharges up to 35 million gallons per day of treated sanitary, stormwater, and industrial wastewater to the Susquehanna River, a Class A waterbody, from an advanced treatment plant located at 4480 Vestal Road, Vestal, NY 13850.

The current SPDES permit for BJCSTP was issued in 2020 and

required the permittee to submit a new SPDES NY-2A application to evaluate effluent quality resultant from facility upgrades completed just prior to issuance of the permit. Therefore, the proposed changes to the limits and requirements within the SPDES permit are based on recent relevant data on performance of the upgraded facility. Additionally, the City of Binghamton's and Village of Johnson City's Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) permits (SPDES ID#s: NY 002 4406 and NY 002 3981, respectively) have been incorporated into the BJCSTP SPDES permit for system-wide consistencies and administrative efficien-
